

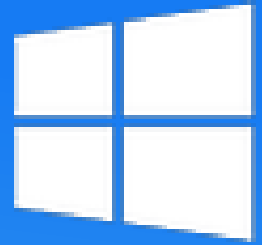

The New Edge Browser does not support add-ins at this time. This means that some things you are used to like ANCESTRY.COM, LastPass and other features may not work correctly until Edge is updated in a few months.

Master the Quick Access Menu

Fast access to the Control Panel, Mobility Center, Power Options, Event Viewer, System, Device Manager, Networking, Disk Management, and more by right-clicking the Start or type WINKEY + X.

Why You Should Get Windows 10 on a New Computer/Tablet

Continuum. This feature lets your 2-in-1 or tablet move automatically between Tablet mode and the normal usage mode as you add/remove keyboards or dock and undock the device.

Why You Should Get Windows 10 on a New Computer/Tablet

Windows Hello. Microsoft's biometric sign-in option requires special hardware in the form of a facial, iris or fingerprint scanner. It is a biometric authentication that provides you instant access to your Windows 10 devices*. Simply show your face or use your fingerprint to login to your new devices running Windows 10 and be immediately recognized and greeted with a smile.

** Windows Hello requires specialized hardware, including fingerprint reader, illuminated IR sensor or other biometric sensors.*
